As I take time to reflect back on 2009, there is much to celebrate but more to do....

In 2009, eight Summit County families became new homeowners through our program and four more families paid off their 20-year, interest-free mortgage and achieved the true dream of a debt free home. We celebrated in style at eight new home dedications and a mortgage burning ceremony for the four that paid off. Each event was a time of praise, glory and an honor for us to share with the families.

We were ever-mindful of the struggling economy and used our donations wisely to keep the cost of administration low. Our program funding and home construction funding was utilized to its fullest potential. Our Habitat ReStore continued to provide new and gently used building materials, appliances and home furnishings at deep discounts to the public. These useable items were bought by members of our community and adapted for reuse. This past year alone, the Summit County ReStore saved over 240 tons of demolition and deconstruction materials from the landfill.

In 2009, we were saddened by the death of Habitat for Humanity founder Millard Fuller, and shared in the renewed faith that this program he created over 32 years ago works for families around the world to be able to live in safe, decent, affordable homes. Millard was buried on Koinonia farmland near his friend and co-founder of Habitat, Clarence Jordan. A simple, decent, pine box serves as Millard's resting place here on earth.

"A Home of Our Own" campaign was launched in 2009 to purchase and renovate the old Handy Andy facility at 2301 Romig Road in an effort to consolidate and move our operations under one roof. In December, we moved and are now continuing to get settled into our new home. Our new location will afford us the resources to serve more families in our community.

We expanded our reach in Summit County last year and built three homes in Stow. Habitat worked side by side with Stow mayor, Karen Fritschel, many faith communities and businesses that helped to fund the home construction. This was truly a milestone that allowed three families to partner with Habitat and create a future for themselves in the Stow community.

In 2009, we worked with the County of Summit Economic Development Department to be a part of the federal legislation that will stabilize neighborhoods in some of the county's most distressed areas. Through this initiative, we are slated to build five new homes and renovate three homes in the Barberton, Norton and Twinsburg Township areas in 2010.

Speaking of 2010 - we will have our annual dinner in March to celebrate with all the funders and volunteers that made 2009 wonderful. In April, we will celebrate 23 years of Habitat for Humanity in Summit County and begin planning our 25th Anniversary Celebration. With your support, we will succeed in our efforts to raise \$2.2 million dollars to support the purchase and renovation of our new home. And....we will serve more families, gain more satisfied ReStore customers and show Summit County that we are alive and well in this struggling economy and here to help those that need simple, decent, affordable homes.

2009 marked the Summit County ReStore's second year of operations. Since the move to its new location on Romig Road, it has not only seen many old familiar faces, but many new ones as well.

ReStore furniture, appliance and material donations have been steadily increasing as people become more aware of the store's environmental and community impact. The ReStore continues to be the store where you shop for yourself and help build homes for others.

2009 University of Akron Campus Chapter

In 2009, Campus Habitat for Humanity at the University of Akron strived to contribute to its community in the four fundamental categories of the Habitat for Humanity mission: Education, Advocacy, Fundraising and Building.

Campus Habitat participated in Act!Speak!Build! Week by hosting a flower pot painting competition at the University between student organizations, and was presented with a State Farm Matching Grant for \$3,000, which they turned over to Habitat for Humanity of Summit County. The chapter ended the spring semester with a corn hole tournament for students and a donation from B.F. Goodrich.

In the fall semester, Campus Habitat participated in World Habitat Day by setting up a table in the student union to educate those who passed by about Habitat for Humanity and the need for decent, affordable shelter throughout the world. The chapter also participated in Make A Difference Day, a community-wide annual day of service. They spent the day working at a Habitat for Humanity of Summit County worksite. Campus Habitat had volunteers at a Habitat for Humanity of Summit County worksite approximately once a month throughout the year.

Campus Habitat sent 24 of its members to Mobile, Ala. for the Collegiate Challenge over its winter break. The group ended up working at a house a block away from the house they built two years ago. These proud members of Campus Habitat also learned that Jimmy Carter had used that house as a base camp for his annual project. During his stay, he said that it was the finest Habitat house he had ever been in. The rest of the week was filled with painting, putting up trim, finishing flooring and roofing. It was a great way to finish 2009!



2009 Wine Tasting & Auction



Our second annual wine tasting event was a huge success! The event was held at Portage Country Club and featured a live and silent auction, local celebrity pourers and raffle for a \$18,000 ruby necklace. The evening raised over \$25,000 to help families in need build the walls, raise the roof and open the door to a brighter future.

2009 HFHSC Tithed

In 2009, Habitat for Humanity of Summit County tithed \$146,583 to building homes in Malawi and other global building projects. To date HFHSC has funded the building of 68.9 homes in Malawi. Globally, the average cost to build a house is currently \$4,500.

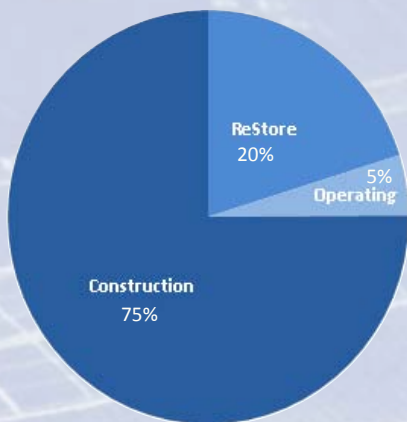

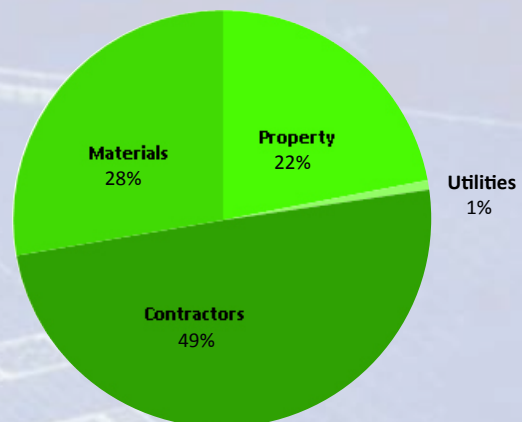

In 2009, the Summit County Department of Community & Economic Development enabled Habitat for Humanity of Summit County to expand its reach into a new Summit County community.

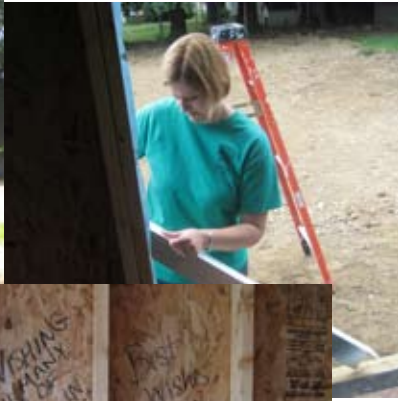
