5 Year Campaign Launch Join the Movement!

Housing instability is linked to poor education and health outcomes amongst the youngest, most vulnerable children in Summit County. Adults also face declining health outcomes and struggle with the stress and anxiety associated with not knowing whether their current housing situation will last. The Imagine Impact campaign was launched to combat these issues. We ask the community to join us in a bold initiative that will bring attention to the need for affordable housing and create transformational change in Summit County. In the next 5 years we aim to build and rehab 75 homes, repair 150 homes, change 1,000 lives, and mobilize 10,000 volunteers in an effort to break families free from this toxic cycle of poverty housing and create a brighter future for our community.
