



Women's Longest Drive: #8 #14 (in fairway)

SCRAMBLE RULES

- 1. Men play from Gray tees (60 and over from Blue tees)
- 2. Women play from Green tees
- 3. Standard scramble format will be used:
 - a. On every hole each team member may hit a shot. The team then selects one of the shots from which to play. All team members must hit from that position.
 - b. There are no restrictions on whose shots or number of drives to use.
 - c. One club-length is allowed to place one's ball no nearer to the hole to improve your lie. Balls must remain in hazards and similar surfaces.
- 4. Please maintain pace of play (ready golf) as the course will be full. Please, no ballhawking. Carts - apply 90 degree rule at all times
- Course specific and weather specific rules will be announced before the tournament begins.
- 6. Tie breaker = in the case of a tie we start at the #1 handicap and go back until we determine a first, second and third place


