Reduction in Cost of High-Speed Internet

In November of 2021, President Biden signed the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Law. This law will rebuild America's roads, bridges, rails and expand access to high-speed internet, tackle the climate crisis, advance environmental justice and invest in communities that have often been left behind. For this article I would like to discuss how this law may benefit our families regarding high-speed internet.

When Congress passed this bi-partisan law, part of this was the Affordable Connectivity Program, which "provides eligible households \$30.00 off per month of their internet bills. Individuals "can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100.00 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers."

In order to qualify for the Affordable Connectivity Program, you must meet one of three qualifications:

- 1. Your income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
- 2. You or someone in the family participates in one of several Assistance programs.
- 3. You meet eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income internet program.

In order to sign up for the program go to https://www.affordableconnectivity.gov. You are able to submit your application on-line or print out a mail-in application. Then you will contact your preferred provider to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill. In order to be enrolled you must fill out the application AND contact your preferred provider. The benefit is available to eligible new, prior and existing customers of participating providers.

Eligible consumers with a past due balance or a balance in collections are eligible for the benefit. You can also combine these benefits with other state and local benefits where available. If you prefer to speak to someone regarding this program, the ACP Support Center number is (877) 384-2575.
