

Tax Time

By the end of February, if not before, many people are starting to prepare to complete their tax returns for the 2022 calendar year. Tax returns for 2022 must be post marked by April 18, 2023. Employers were required to get W2s and 1099s by January 31st.

You will need your W2 or 1099-NEC. You may also need information from your child care provider. If you have made donations to non-profits, you may need the receipts they provided. You also may receive other 1099s from any of your investments you may have.

Most US citizens and permanent residents need to file a tax return if they meet income requirements. In order to find out what these guidelines are, follow the IRS website link at the end of this article. If you had federal income tax withheld, qualify to claim tax credits such as Earned Income Tax Credit or the Child Tax Credit, or if you made estimated tax payments, you may want to file even if you did not make the required income to file. There are many tax preparation software options. There are also several free websites to prepare taxes. The United Way offers volunteer tax preparation for those who qualify. The link to get more information about this service is

Some may wonder why file a tax return? Filing allows you to get a refund if you overpaid your required taxes. Filing allows you to avoid added interest and penalties if you did not have enough taxes withheld. There is a penalty for the month or part of a month that your tax return is late. Failure to file a tax return if you are required to file, can be considered a federal crime.

When you file your taxes, you have a choice of taking a standard deduction or itemizing. Itemizing can allow you to deduct "state and local income or sales tax, real estate taxes, personal property taxes, mortgage interest, and disaster losses." Keep in mind, as Habitat home owners, you will not have any interest that can be deducted since our mortgages are 0% interest. Many tax preparation softwares will help you decide whether standard deduction or itemizing will be best for you.

The count down has started. The sooner you can get your taxes filed the sooner you may receive any refund. Also, keep in mind, you may need an appointment with a tax preparer. If you have further questions, it is always a good idea to make an appointment with a tax preparer. Tax preparers are aware of the latest laws and regulations to help you make the best choices for your specific situation.


